STEP 0. DOWNLOAD SUBLIME TEXT FOR YOUR SPECIFIC OS



- 1. Go to https://www.sublimetext.com/
- 2. Click on "Download" button
- 3. For Windows, check CPU Version
  - 3.1. go to the search bar and type in "System Information"
  - 3.2. look for "System Type" on the right side
  - 3.3. Windows has 32 bit or 64 bit. Step 3.2. will tell you which one

1. For **Windows**, go to **"Documents"** folder and make a new folder. Give the folder your name 2. For **Mac**, go to the **"Desktop"** and make a new folder. Give the folder your name.

### **STEP 2. CREATE WEBSITE**

1. Open Sublime Text

2. Highlight and copy the code from the curriculum you are currently working and then paste it into Sublime Text

- 3. Go to the top left and click on "Save As"
- 4. Go to the folder you created in Step 1
- 5. Look down below to the field "File Name" and type in the name of the project you are

currently working on. Then, add ".html" at the end

- 6. Click on "Save"
- 7. You have just saved your code into a web format and it is now a website on your computer
